



### Jeremiah 1:4-8

- 4 Now the word of the Lord came to me, saying,
- 5 “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations.”
- 6 Then I said, “Ah, Lord God! Behold, I do not know how to speak, for I am only a youth.”
- 7 But the Lord said to me, “Do not say, ‘I am only a youth’; for to all to whom I send you, you shall go, and whatever I command you, you shall speak.
- 8 Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you to deliver you, declares the Lord.”

### Ephesians 2:10

- 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them

### 2 Timothy 3:16-17

- 16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,
- 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

*Follow the instructions to discover truth for yourself.*

1. Read Jeremiah 1:4-5. Mark every reference to the Lord (including pronouns) with a triangle and make a list of what you learn.

When did God's activity start in Jeremiah's life?

Note the 4 verbs used to describe God's activity. What do you learn from these?

2. Read Jeremiah 1:6. Mark pronouns referring to Jeremiah with a circle. Make a list of what you learn.

How does Jeremiah feel about God's call on his life?  
What are the issues that cause him to doubt?

3. Read Jeremiah 1:7-8. Mark the Lord and pronouns as before. List what you learn.

What does the Lord tell Jeremiah he must do?  
How will Jeremiah be equipped to do it?

**Was this just time for Jeremiah?**

4. Read Ephesians 2:10. Underline the word 'we' and list what you learn.

When were these good works prepared for us?

**How does God equip us?**

5. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. Number in the text the different things that Scripture is profitable for. Put a box around the word 'that'.

What is the source of Scripture?

What is the outcome in v7 of its activity in our lives?

*As Jeremiah was called and equipped through God speaking, so we too are equipped as we listen in to His Word and allow it to teach us, reprove us, correct us and train us.*
